



COVERAGE THAT IS PROVIDED BY THIS LIMITED WARRANTY

Electric or Gas Motor, Transaxle, Charger Plug Receptacle, Electronic Speed Controller, 48-Volt to 12-Volt Converter, Brake Assembly, Pedal Assembly, Wheel Hub & Bearings, Spindle & Swing Arm Assemblies, Steering Shaft and Components, Bearings, Bushings, Fittings, Leaf Springs, Shocks, Main & Sub Electrical Wiring Harnesses, Controller, MCOR, Computer Fail Safe System, On Board Signal Generator, Lighting System. Parts classified under a different description or of similar function, like or kind will be covered respectively. Electric Golf Cars have a \$0 (Zero) deductible. A \$50 deductible will be applied for all Gas Golf Cars for each covered claim.

Pick-Up/Delivery reimbursement may be available for your covered claim. EWG will pay up to \$50 to the Authorized Service Center in cases where you are unable to transport your electric vehicle. Restrictions may apply. Posted labor rates of the Authorized Service Center will be honored for covered claims with a not to exceed labor rate of ninety-five dollars (\$95.00) per hour. EWG reserves the right to approve or deny claims and will pay labor time to complete covered repairs based on a preapproved labor rate chart.

Fluid loss, shop supplies, maintenance items, adjustments, alignment, tires, batteries, battery charger, diagnosis fees, freight, and state or local tax are excluded from coverage. Parts that are not expressly listed are not covered.

WHAT TO DO IN THE EVENT OF A MECHANICAL BREAKDOWN

Contact EWG Claims Department using any of the three methods listed to initiate a claim on your Limited Warranty: Phone: 1-833-394-2677, Email: claims@ewgcorp.com (include your name, contract#, serial #, brief description of the issue you are experiencing) or you may also contact your issuing Dealer to initiate a claim.

In all cases, you must contact EWG or your Issuing Dealer prior to proceeding with any repairs. EWG will coordinate work, authorize service, and provide payment or reimburse to the Authorized Service Center for all covered repairs on behalf of the Issuing Legion Dealer. Any work performed without written consent could result in the voiding of your Limited Warranty.

It is your duty to use all reasonable means and precautions to protect the electric vehicle from further damage as a result of mechanical breakdown. Continued operation of the electric vehicle after any mechanical breakdown occurs constitutes a failure to protect the vehicle in all cases, and any further damage as a result of your failure to protect the vehicle shall not be recoverable. All known mechanical issues or claims must be filed within 24 hours of said failure or problem.
